COACHES MEMORIAL TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is open to all youth members in good standing with the FCUSBC. All rules not specifically covered will be governed by USBC. The tournament director shall have the final decision in all disputes. All entrants must be certified by USBC.
2. Check in time is from 12:00 - 12:45pm - Bowl Est. 1:00pm
3. This is a singles Pee Wee 8 Pin No Tap, USBC 9 Pin No Tap event. Entry fee is \$14.00.
4. There are four (4) divisions -- Three (3) divisions based on the average divisions used in the Association Championship Tournament and one (1) Pee Wee division.
5. Individual highest averages as of October 30, 2016 will be used (minimum 12 games). If no October 30th average, then the following will be used with a minimum of 12 games: Summer 2016 average, then 2015-2016 Yearbook will be used. The Tournament Director may re-rate.
6. Handicap is based on 100% of 220 as used in the Association Tournament.
7. In accordance with rule 17D, proper attire is required. No apparel advertising tobacco, drugs or alcohol, profane suggestions, short shorts, halters, tank-tops or head apparel will be allowed. The tournament officials will determine proper attire. The Tournament Director will have the right to ask any bowler to change their clothing. If the bowler refuses, he or she will not be allowed to bowl and the entry fee will not be refunded. Unsportsmanlike conduct, profane language or obscene gestures will not be permitted. Any violation of the above rules will be grounds for expulsion from this tournament. No unnecessary delays will be allowed.
8. Awards will be given to the top three (3) male and female bowlers in each division. The top youth bowler with the highest overall handicap series out of all divisions will be awarded the floating trophy to display at their bowling center for a period of one year, and then it will again return to the tournament. The floating trophy will be presented in the memory of deceased coaches.
9. Only bowlers, scorers and tournament officials will be allowed in the bowlers circle and tournament office at ANY TIME.
10. Any discrepancies must be brought immediately to the attention of the tournament director (or tournament committee member) The decision of the tournament director shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with rule 329.
11. The 2016 - 2017 USBC rulebook will govern any ungoverned situation not covered here.
