

Bowling Achievement

First Coast USBC Youth Hall of Fame Nomination

Updated, November 2023

Purpose: To honor a past FCUSBC Youth bowler for outstanding performance in the sport of Youth Bowling on a local, state, and/or national level.

Award: The Hall of Fame Committee may select one (1) Boy and one (1) Girl for Bowling Achievement each year. However, a 3rd nominee may be selected by the Committee. The honorees shall receive an award presented at the annual Coaches Memorial Ceremony. The bowling center they represent shall receive a commemorative certificate of appreciation.

Eligibility: Nominees must have been a member in the FCUSBC Youth Program for a minimum of three (3) years. Must have completed Youth Bowling and maximum age of twenty-six (26) as of the current bowling season. Must have demonstrated exemplary sportsmanship.

Nominee must have participated in a minimum of:

Five or more First Coast USBC Youth events: (City Tournament, JJBT, NFSSS, Scholarship Tournament)

Three or more Florida State USBC Youth events: (Pepsi / FL Handicap, State Scholarship, Landen)

Nominee must meet certain performance levels:

Boys: 5 – 275+ games, 2 – 11-in-a-row games or 1 – 300 game, or 3 – 750+ series or 1 – 800+ series,
And 180+ average for 2 years or 200+ average for 1 year

Girls: 2 – 275+ games, 1 – 11-in-a-row game or 1 – 300 game, or 1 – 700+ series,
And 170+ average for 2 years or 180+ average for 1 year

Two (2) Major Events Achievements/Awards from the following list:

Local: JJBT TOC Championship (Masters Division)

or 5 top 5 finishes in JJBT Regular Events

Debbi Parsons Scholarship Tournament Championship

or 2 top 5 finishes

NFSSS event champion - division (3 time minimum)

1st Place championship in City Tournament

Named to All-City Team at least twice

James Burroughs / Kathy Kuchler Petersen Award Winner

State: Florida Pepsi Tournament champion

Florida Handicap Tournament champion

Florida State Scholarship Tournament champion

Landen Tournament champion

Nomination: Anyone may submit the name of the Youth to the FCUSBC Youth Hall of Fame Committee.

Annual deadline- December 31.

Nominees not selected will be considered one additional year without resubmission.
