

First Coast USBC Youth Committee Coaches Hall of Fame Nomination

Updated, November 2024

Purpose: To honor individuals for volunteering their time and their dedication to Coaching the sport of Youth Bowling within the First Coast USBC.

Award: The Hall of Fame Committee may select one (1) Coach each year. The honoree shall receive an award presented at the annual Coaches Memorial Ceremony. The bowling center they represent shall receive a commemorative certificate of appreciation.

Eligibility: Nominees must have coached in the FCUSBC Youth Program for a minimum of **four (4) years** and the nominee must have been actively coaching for three (3) years out of the most recent five (5) years. Nominee also must have reached a minimum Coaching Certification of Level I.

Nomination: Anyone may submit the name of a Coach to the FCUSBC Youth Hall of Fame Committee. Annual deadline- December 31.

Nominees not selected will be considered one additional year without resubmission.
