COACHES MEMORIAL TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is open to all youth members under the age of 18 (as of 8/1/2024) of the First Coast USBC in good standing with the FCUSBC and USBC. **Youth entrants cannot have participated in an Adult prize-fund league within the past 12 months or have lost youth member eligibility (excluding Adult/Youth Leagues).** Eligible, active youth league coaches that participate in this event must also be USBC members AND Registered Volunteers (RVP's) in good standing. Current and newly-inducted Youth Hall of Fame members are eligible and considered "Alumni".
2. Check-in times are from 9:00am—10:00am AND for 15 minutes after the conclusion of the Awards Ceremony. Tournament start time is estimated at 11:30am, but no earlier than 15 minutes after the ceremony concludes.
3. This is a Singles Pee Wee 8-Pin No Tap or 9-Pin No Tap format event. Entry fee is \$15.00 for all divisions/entrants. (Lineage \$10.50, Expenses \$1.00, Prize \$2.50, \$1.00 Scholarship)
4. There are six (6) Divisions — Three (3) divisions based on the average divisions used in the Association Youth Tournament, one (1) Pee Wee division, one (1) Coaches division, and one (1) Alumni division. Youth bowlers with Level 1 coach rank may enter Coaches Division but are not eligible for prizes.
5. Youth Average: An individual's highest league average as of January 1st, 2025 will be used (minimum 12 games). If no 1/1/2025 average, then the following will be used (min. 12 games): Summer 2024 average, then 2023-2024 Yearbook. The Tournament Director may re-rate any entrant at their discretion. Sport averages to be converted to standard averages.
6. Handicap for the Pee Wee and Youth Divisions are based on 100% of 230, as used in the Association's Youth City Tournament. The Coaches and Alumni Divisions are bowled as scratch with no handicap or average verification.
7. In accordance with Rule 17(d), proper attire is required. Tournament officials will determine proper attire and will verify at check-in. The Tournament Director has the right to ask any bowler to change their clothing — If the bowler refuses, he or she will not be allowed to bowl, and the entry fee will not be refunded.
8. Earbuds and headphones are allowed, but all bowlers must be ready to bowl when it is their turn.
9. Awards will be given to the top two (2) male and female bowlers in each youth division; no awards will be given to entrants in the Coaches division. The top youth bowler with the highest overall handicap series among all divisions will be awarded the floating trophy, to be displayed at their bowling center for a period of one year and returned to the tournament. The floating trophy is presented in the memory of deceased coaches.
10. Any discrepancies must be immediately brought to the attention of the Tournament Director (or Tournament Committee Member). The decisions of the Tournament Director are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.
